ISPE Membership Levels:

Associate Member – Entrance level to the Society.

Member – Members are eligible to vote on Society issues.

Fellow – Exemplifying the goals of the Society, Fellows become eligible to hold appointive office.

Senior Fellow – A person of superior accomplishments, who has mastered the ideals of the Society that persons both inside and outside the Society have benefited from association with this individual. At this level, a member becomes eligible for elective office.

Senior Research Fellow – A person of outstanding achievement and contributions to mankind, exemplifying the highest expression of the ideals of the Society and recognized for accomplishments outside the Society that have contributed to the betterment of humanity.

Diplomate – A person distinguished among colleagues by having demonstrated exemplary performance and achievements within the Society and recognized for accomplishments outside the Society that may be construed as beneficial to humanity in general.

Philosopher – Awarded to an outstanding member of Fellow level or above. Cannot be applied for and is made unanimously through a selection committee.

Mentors and Honorary Members – Distinguished individuals from outside the Society whose accomplishments for the benefit and betterment of humanity are in consonance with the Society's ideals and will reflect favorably upon the Society.
