For many reasons, 2020 was an unusual year. That shouldn't be news to anyone! But did you know that October 10, 2020, was also a most peculiar date? You may not have realized it, but at 55 seconds past midnight on that day, the time and date was as shown below.

00:55, 10/10/2020

This can be represented by the following pattern, where x = 5, 2x = 10, and 4x = 20:

00:xx, 2x/2x/4x4x

From the year 0 AD (or 0 CE) until today, there have been only five occurrences of this time/date pattern. The most recent one was given above.

- 1. What were the other four time and date combinations that also fit the pattern above?
- 2. What time and date in the future will fit the same pattern?

1. The previous four time and date combinations were as follows:

00:44, 8/8/1616 00:33, 6/6/1212 00:22, 4/4/0808 (the year 808) 00:11, 2/2/0404 (the year 404)

2. Never! That was the last time that the time/date combination will fit the pattern 00:xx, 2x/2x/4x4x, which makes it even more unusual! Ω
