## Wordscreens

A "wordscreen" is a completed rectangle of letters that can be rearranged to spell a given word. Letter orientation is variable. Black spaces are included as part of the wordscreen rectangle, but empty white spaces are not, as there will be no empty white spaces in a completed puzzle.

On the right is an example of a partially completed puzzle with valid wordscreens of the following words:

APE, TURN, CLIMB, TAMING, FOREIGN, COMPRISE, and HEARTIEST.

Color coding is used in this example just to show placement of each rectangular wordscreen.

Note that, in this example, MUSIC (along the right edge) is not a wordscreen because of the space between the letter M and the letter U .
